SCHOOL CROSSING PATROL

On Wednesday Judy, our new crossing patrol lady, came in to speak to the children about using the crossing safely. The session was very informative. Two important points that she made were crossing in front of her so that she knows where you are at all times and waiting until she invites you to cross so that you are sure the traffic has stopped and it is safe. Why not ask your child about some of the information she gave?

Judy did also raise the issue of cars parking near the crossing and blocking the area for traffic. This is a continuous message but please think when you are parking. The crossing area needs to be clear to give pedestrians and drivers a clear view of all that is happening.

SCHOOL CERTIFICATES
