On Friday 25 May we will be holding a wish day in aid of the Starlight charity which helps seriously and terminally ill children.

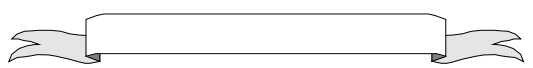
We are asking the children to come to school dressed up as whatever they ever dreamed of being, whether it be a fairy or pirate, a racing driver or pop star.
