HARVEST MASS



Our annual family harvest Mass will be held at St Mary's Church on next Saturday, 20 October at 6pm. Once again we would like to ask families to send in contributions of food for the harvest baskets that are distributed to elderly parishioners after Mass. Gifts of tinned or packet goods can be sent in to school any time next week but we would ask that fresh goods (fruit or veg) are not sent to school until Thursday or Friday. This Mass is a lovely start to the year and the letters of thanks we receive are always heartfelt and sincere. You are always very generous with your contributions so thank you in advance. As we will be leading this special Mass we will be needing children to help with the readings, bidding prayers and the offertory, if your child would like to help please fill in the form sent out earlier this week and return to school as soon as possible.

SCHOOL BUILDING FUND

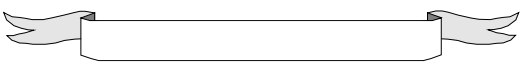
